- Include one or two images of your work to be selected for the brochure.
- Horizontal or square images will work best in the brochure design. Vertical will work, but avoid extra tall or extra wide images

## **Image Requirements**

For Photographers:

• Send the images of your work at 300 dpi, 1500 pixels on the longer side. No need to photograph the photograph.

### For All Artists:

- If you're not sure how to create 300 dpi photos that are 1500 pixels on the longer side, please Google your camera or phone settings. Choose "large" or "extralarge". The Brochure Coordinator can adjust the size in Photoshop.
- Do not send images that are under 300 dpi, no matter what the size of the actual artwork. The photo needs to be 300 dpi for printing in the brochure or the image will be muddy and grainy.

## For 2D Artists:

- Remove any glass in front of your work so there is no glare.
- Take the photo of just your art. Do not include the frame.

#### For 3D Artists:

- Important: Photograph your artwork on a neutral background, such as a big piece of
  white butcher paper or cloth. Since the images that will be in the brochure are
  small, any other kind of background will be too busy and can muddy the image of
  the artwork itself.
- Important: Label image with your Last name, First Name, Title of Work, Medium.
   EXAMPLE: Mahar\_Ken \_Necking\_ Photography
